David Krut Projects, edition~verso, 50ty50ty and The Artist's Press.

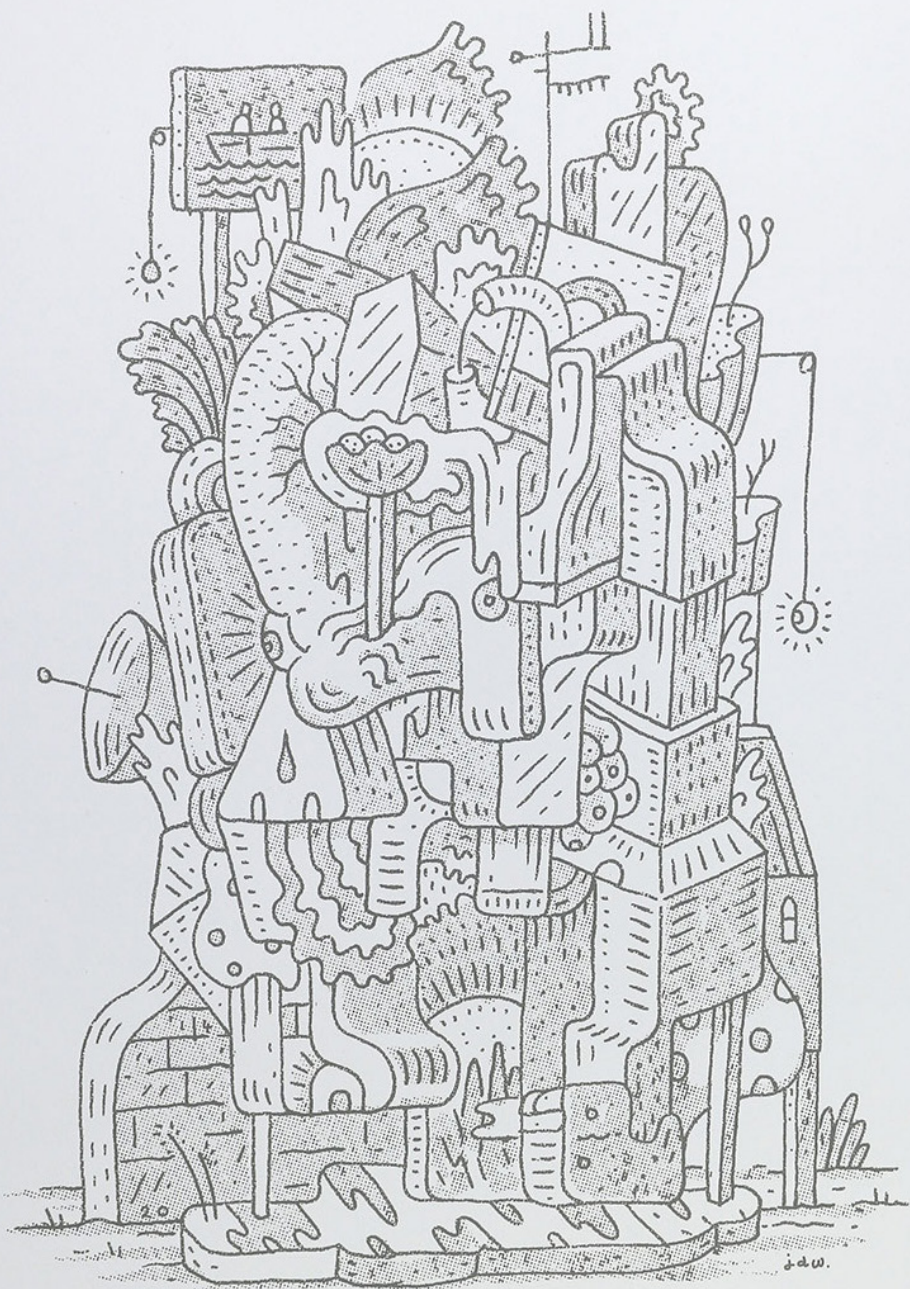

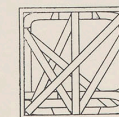
**WE AIM TO ENGAGE IN ECONOMIC SYSTEMS THAT VALUE PEOPLE OVER PROFIT.**

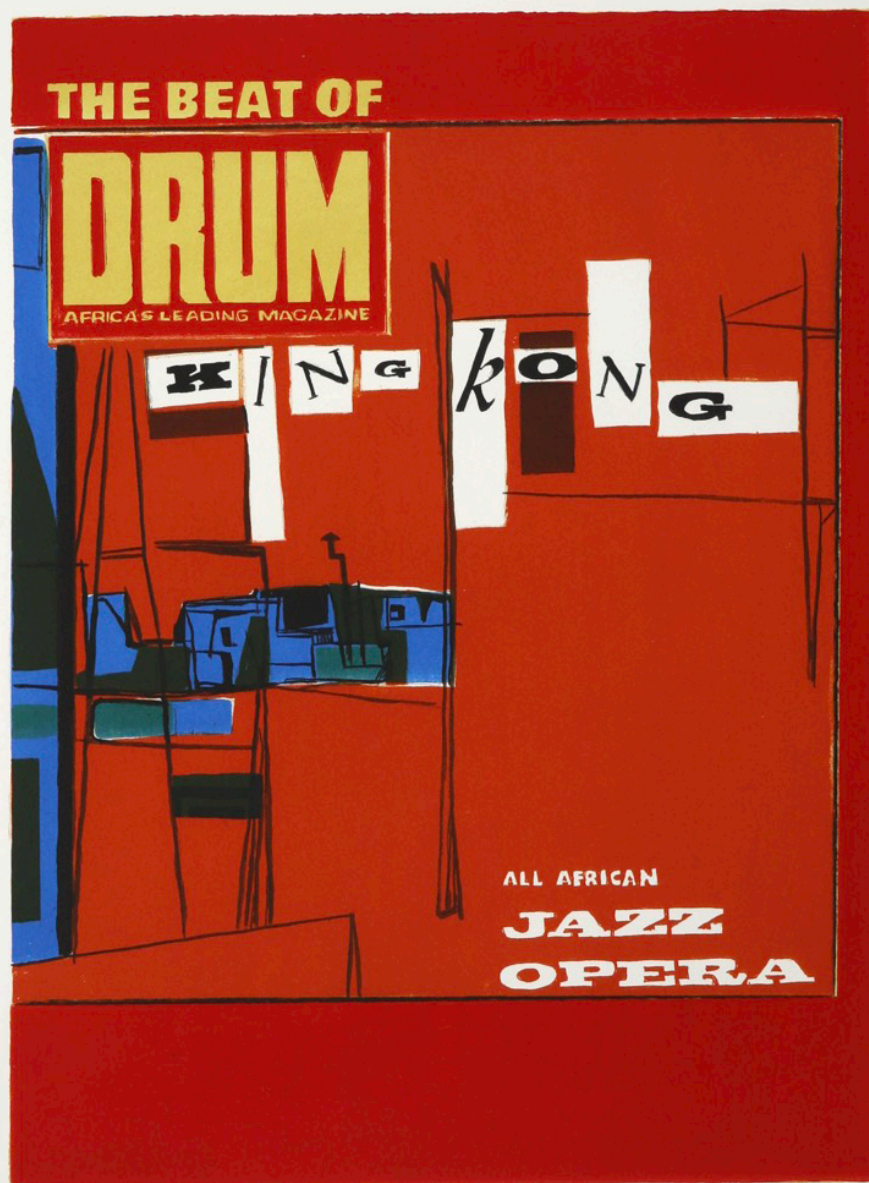

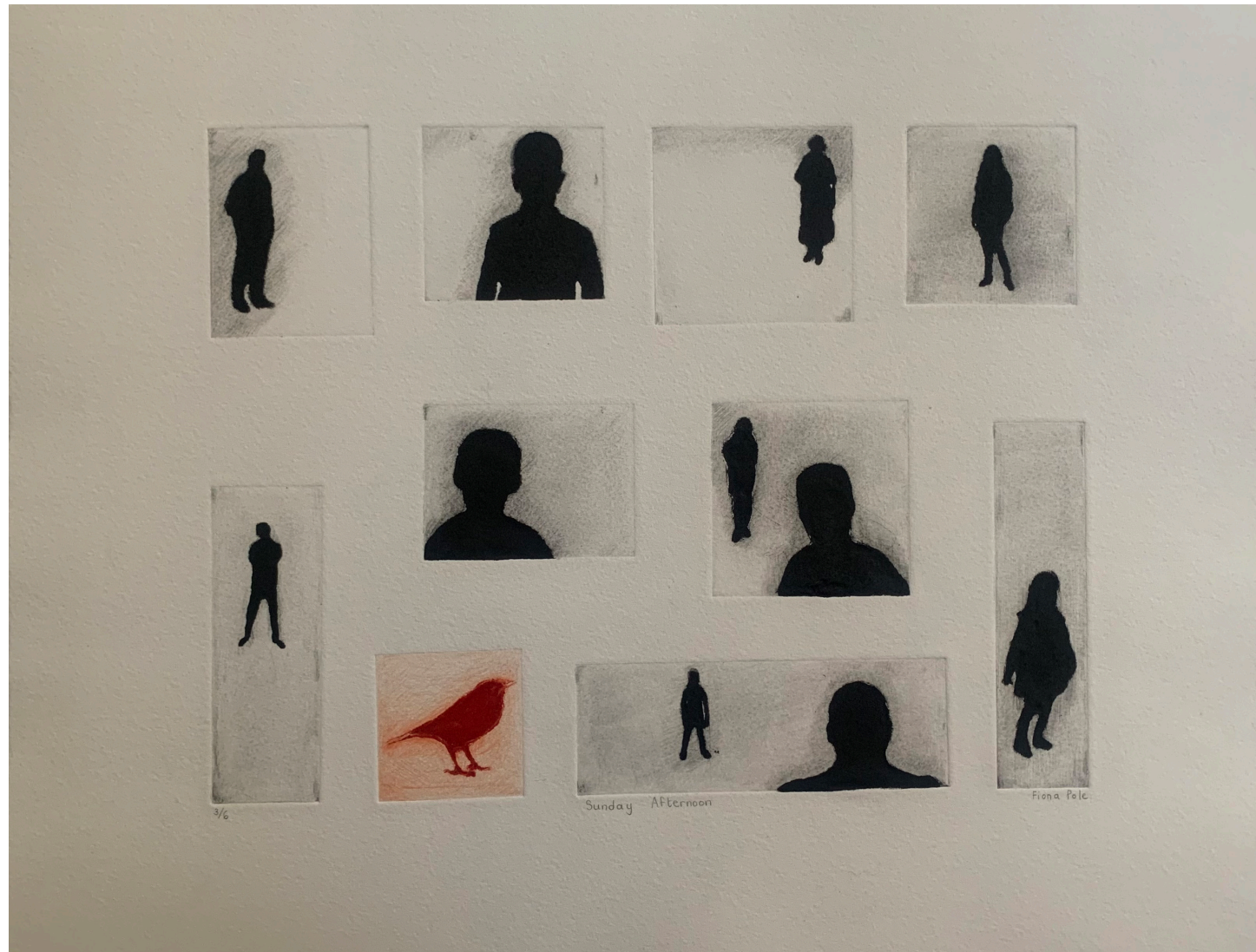

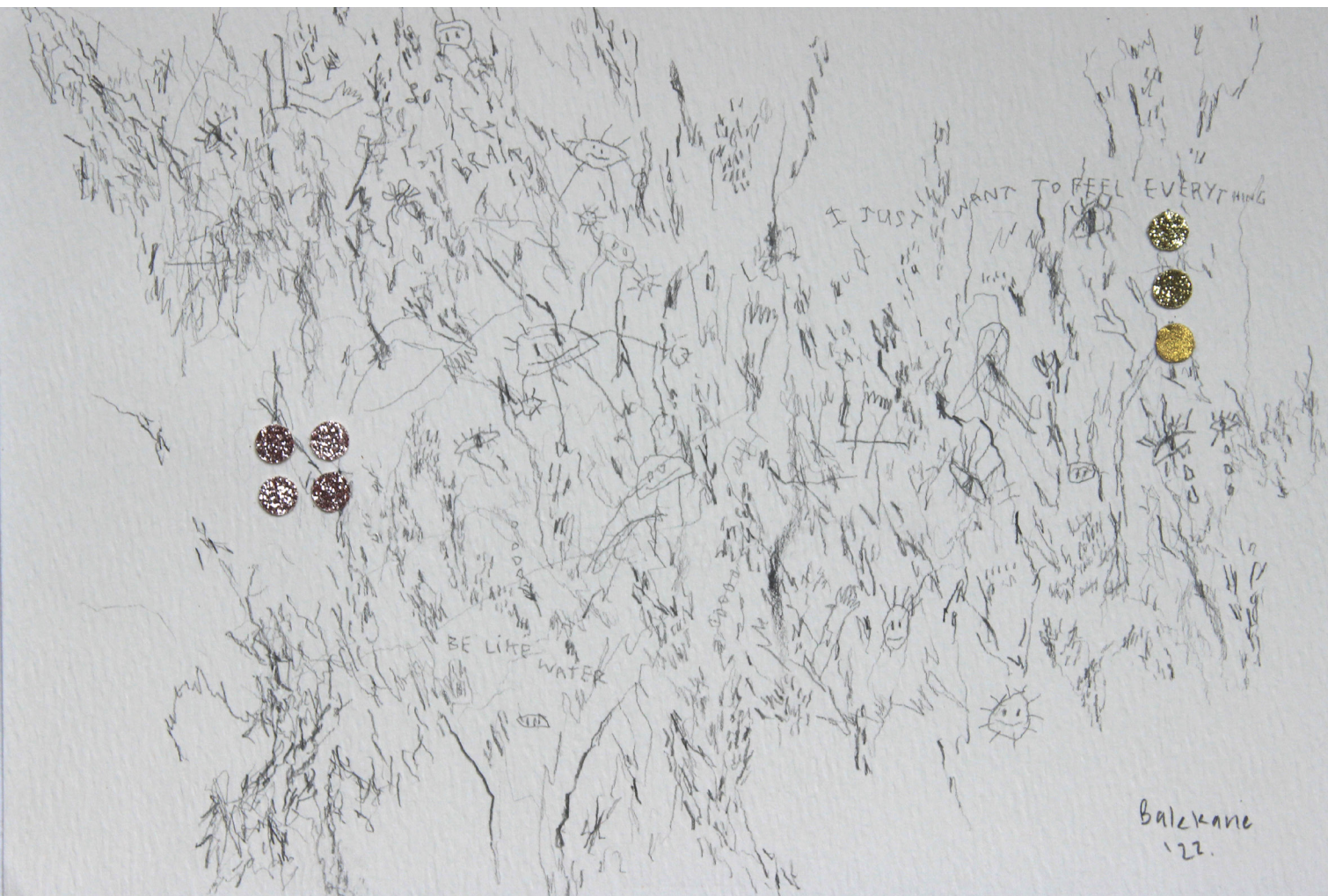

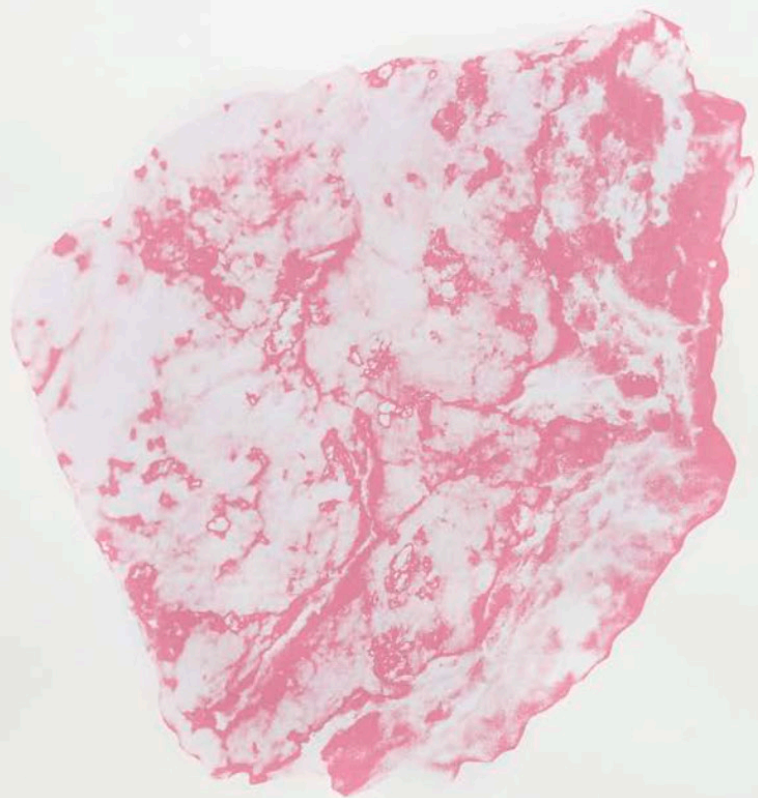
